

6th Grade Art Supply List

During the marking period that you receive Art as your Talent class, please have access to the following art supplies:

- Drawing pencils (not mechanical pencils)
- Sharpener
- Erasers (any type)
- Liquid glue (ex. Elmer's school glue)
- Glue stick
- Black permanent markers (fine point and ultra-fine point tips)
- Color Pencils
- Crayons
- Markers- various colors (ex. Crayola cone tip markers)
- Cotton Swabs for blending
- Old magazines, cardboard, yarn, etc. to be used for collage projects

7th & 8th grade Art Students

You will need the following supplies for your art class this year. You are responsible for replenishing supplies as needed.

- Drawing pencil set (a variety of pencils for ex: 2B, 4B, 6B, H)
- Sharpener
- Erasers (any kind, a kneaded eraser is helpful for blending)
- Liquid glue (ex. Elmer's school glue)
- Glue Stick
- Black permanent markers (fine point and ultra-fine point tips)
- Color Pencils (Crayola or Prismacolor recommended)
- Crayons (Crayola recommended)
- Markers- various colors (ex. Crayola cone tip markers)
- Cotton Swabs for blending
- Old magazines, cardboard, yarn, etc. to be used for collage projects

During the second semester, 7th & 8th grade art students will have the opportunity to use the art materials of your choice for independent projects. You do not need to purchase these supplies until you have created a plan for your projects.

Examples of art materials you may want to use:

- Watercolor paint set
- Brushes
- Acrylic Paints
- Sculpture materials ex. recyclables, cardboard, clay, wood, etc.
- Oil pastels and/or chalk pastels
- Canvas paint boards
- Sewing materials (fabric, thread, etc)
- Weaving materials (yarn)

If you cannot find a material that is listed, please feel free to substitute with a material that is similar. Brand names are not important, but Crayola is recommended for most supplies as their art supplies are reasonable priced and accessible from various suppliers.
